ENTERTAINMENT AT THE FEBRUARY MEETING

On August 18th, 2000 the Russian nuclear submarine, Kursk, was participating in naval exercises with other Russian Naval Vessels in the Barents Sea when it unexpectedly sank with its crew of 118 men onboard.

Though rescue attempts were offered by the British and Norwegian teams, Russia declined initial rescue offers. All 118 sailors and officers aboard Kursk perished. The Russian Admiralty at first suggested most of the crew died within minutes of the explosion; however, some of the sailors had time to write notes.

A consortium formed by the Dutch companies Mammoet and Smit International eventually raised the Kursk and recovered the dead who were buried in Russia.

The video documents some of the controversy that surrounded the accident and the effort exerted to finally recover the Kursk.


