ISHNALA SUPPER CLUB 52011 Ishnala Road Lake Delton, WI 53940 Sunday, September 29

In the language of the Winnebago Indian, Ishnala means "By Itself Alone" Symbolized by the point of rock extending into the peaceful water of Mirror Lake, long before the arrival of the first settlers, Ishnala was a ceremonial ground for the Winnebago Indians.

Minutes from Wisconsin Dells, Ishnala Supper Club is nestled among the tall Norway Pines overlooking the majestic Mirror Lake in the middle of Mirror Lake State Park. At Ishnala Supper Club fine dining joins with nature to create a truly memorable dining experience.

Ishnala has a long rich history having been first established long before the arrival of the first settlers by the Winnebago Tribe who used the land as ceremonial grounds. Pioneer settlers purchased Ishnala from the tribe in 1826 and constructed a log cabin trading post. In 1909 Ishnala was sold to the Coleman family who converted the property into their dream home, and in 1953, Ishnala was purchased by the Hoffman Brothers who built Ishnala as it is today.

In 1973, Ishnala's current owner, Robert Prosser, began working as a busboy for the Hoffman Brothers' 8 restaurants, and over many years, he worked his way up to work directly with the Hoffman's in the management of their restaurants which included Ishnala. Robert considers it a great honor and privilege to continue the outstanding tradition that that began in 1953.

After or successful outing last year to a Wisconsin Supper Club we decided to head this year to Ishnala in Lake Delton, which is 2 hours and 35 minutes from my house in Mt. Prospect (for some of you it could be over 3 hours), so we are thinking of staying overnight there. Cost for dinner at Ishnala range from \$50 to \$100 depending on what you eat and drink. Lodging will run another \$130 to \$165.

PRIOR NOTICE OF MOTION TO AMEND BYLAWS FOR VOTE AT BUSINESS MEETING OF TUES SEPT 24th

The Board of Directors is proposing a reduction in dues due to recent reductions in our cost structure. If approved, this reduction would take place in the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024, lowering dues from \$48 to \$40 per Triton member and from \$72 to \$60 per Triton married couple. This requires a change in the bylaws as detailed below, which must be approved by 2/3 of the membership in attendance at the business meeting where it is presented for vote.

This notice constitutes prior notice required by the Bylaws. Vote will take place at the business meeting of Tuesday September 24th.

BYLAWS ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP Section 4: Dues, fees, and special assessments Part C, as written today:

The dues shall be four dollars (\$4.00) per month per individual or six dollars (\$6.00) per month per married couple, payable annually during the month of October. The initial dues notice shall be sent in the month of September. Members who have not paid their dues by November 1st shall be sent one reminder notice by the Treasurer stating that if their dues are not received by the December Board of Directors meeting, their membership status shall be changed to Suspended and be subject to Article III, Section 3, Paragraph B.

BYLAWS ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP Section 4: Dues, fees, and special assessments Part C, with proposed change <u>underlined</u>:

The dues shall be <u>\$40.00 per year per individual</u> or <u>\$60.00 per year per married couple</u>, payable annually during the month of October. The initial dues notice shall be sent in the month of September. Provo Turks and Caicos February 22, 2025 to March 1, 2025

Turks and Caicos is an archipelago of 40 low-lying coral islands in the Atlantic Ocean, a British Overseas Territory southeast of the Bahamas. The gateway island of Providenciales, known as Provo. Scuba-diving sites include a 14-mile barrier reef on Provo's north shore. We haven't been here in over 20 years so now seems to be a good time to go down there and see what's new. From what I can tell the place has grown significantly. So, here is what you need to know in order to go.

The package includes:

I have 14 dive spots and 8 rooms reserved for the group. 2 balcony/terrace rooms and 6 standard plus rooms. The 2 balcony/terrace rooms have already been taken. If you want this room category, please contact me and I will see what can be arranged. Also, there are no elevators at the resort so if you need a ground floor room we will need to make this request as soon as possible.

A \$100.00 per person deposit is required to confirm a spot in the group. Deposit will be refundable if cancelled before final payment is due. Deposit and final payment must be done by check made payable to Global Access, Inc.
