The Richard H. Driehaus Museum explores the art, architecture, and design of the late 19th and early 20th centuries with a focus on the Gilded Age. The Museum is located just steps from the Magnificent Mile within the meticulously restored [Nickerson Mansion](#), renowned as Gilded Age Chicago's "Marble Palace." The exquisite building was saved twice, first by a collective of over [100 Chicago citizens](#) in 1919, and then by philanthropist [Richard H. Driehaus](#), who sponsored its [restoration from 2003-2008](#). Mr. Driehaus founded the Museum to feature his outstanding collection of decorative arts—particularly Tiffany glass. Trip Advisor names this as one of the Top Ten Things to do in Chicago. Guided Tours Available if we get a large enough group (need 10). Cost is \$20 per person, \$15 for seniors, if we do the guided tour it is an additional \$5 per person. And we will have lunch somewhere in the area once we are finished at the museum.
