After the service he was active in VFW Post 2088, Toys for Tots, helping the homeless veterans. He was a volunteer firefighter and EMT for the village of Norridge.

Since the date was changed from Memorial Day to July 10, and from a Sunday to a Saturday, we were fortunate to have some guests who usually can't come, so that was a treat, although we missed usual attendees who are Saturday workers or were out of town.

There were only 5 bicyclists this year, so we may have to call the event the Eat, Walk, and Bike Ride next year.
