The Historical & Architectural Cruise typically runs 1.5 to 2 hours, depending on the schedule of the Chicago locks. This tour highlight Chicago's landscape and architecture from Lake Michigan and the Chicago River, showing how it has developed over time from stockyards to steakhouses, and bringing millions of tourists to a once desolated area which is now thriving.

The boat is docked near the Columbia Yacht Club and our tour is at 3:00 PM., so please arrive no later than 2:45. It is docked on the pier between Monroe and DuSable Harbors, just east of Millennium & Maggie Daley Parks, and about a mile south of Navy Pier - address of the harbor marina 111 N. Lakeshore Drive. Cost is \$32.00 per person. Parking is \$20 for the first 3 hours, which should be enough time.

OLD JOLIET PRISON TOUR 1125 COLLINS ST., JOLIET, IL SUNDAY, AUGUST 7

Join your fellow Tritons for a guided history tour of Old Joliet Prison on Sunday, August 7. The prison was built in 1858 and in operation until 2002. The prison was featured in the film *The Blues Brothers*. The tour is approximately 90 minutes long and is mostly outside. The tour docent will takes us to the East and West Cell Houses, North Segregation, Cafeteria, Chapel and the Honor Dorm. The tour begins at 11:00 and every person will be required to sign in, so I suggest we **gather at the prison around 10:30**. The **cost is \$30** and **tickets are nonrefundable**. You can make your checks out to the Tritons.
