

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRITON SCUBA CLUB



Welcome to associate membership in the Triton Skin and Scuba Diving Club! As an associate member you have all the privileges of membership (except voting), including meetings, dives, social events, monthly copies of the newsletter, continuing diving education opportunities, and limited use of Club equipment. Admission to full membership shall be after completion of all requirements listed below (which must be completed in a 12-month period), and after the recommendation of the Membership Committee.

Requirements fall into 2 basic categories:

1. Attend at least 2 Triton non-dive activities (meetings or social events)

Business meetings are held the fourth Tuesday of every month (except December) at a location announced on our website. Meetings begin at 7:30pm.

Social events provide us with opportunities to get to know each other above the water. See the events calendar for designated social events. For a social event to count towards club membership requirements, please fill out the Verification of Associate Social Event form signed by the event Triton-In-Charge (TIC) and return to the Membership Chairman.

2. Complete at least two non-training dives:

- Each dive must be with a different full Triton member.
- Only one dive will count for a given day.

* Training dives are not applicable towards membership requirements.

Dive reports must be completed by the associate and the Triton buddy and turned in to the Membership Chairman within 60 days of when the dive was made. After that the dive will not count towards membership requirements. The dive report is a very important document not only because it assures us of the safe diving practices of our new members, but also because it gives associates a chance to receive feedback on diving abilities from an experienced diver.

NOTE - It is the responsibility of the associate member to turn in the dive report form, not the Triton Full Member.
